When Strong Men Are Weak

Samson was an incredibly strong man with a dangerously weak will.

THREE ATTITUDES THAT MAKE STRONG MEN WEAK:

Judges 14:1-2 Samson went down to Timnah and saw there a young Philistine woman. When he returned, he said to his father and mother, "I have seen a Philistine woman in Timnah; now get her for me as my wife."

Judges 14:8-9 Sometime later, when he went back to marry her, he turned aside to look at the lion's carcass, and in it he saw a swarm of bees and some honey. He scooped out the honey with his hands and ate as he went along.

Judges 14:10 Now his father went down to see the woman. And there Samson held a feast, as was customary for young men.
