

SAMSON'S SMALL STEPS TO BIG DESTRUCTION

1. Samson _____ his enemy.

Judges 16:3 But Samson lay there only until the middle of the night. Then he got up and took hold of the doors of the city gate, together with the two posts, and tore them loose, bar and all. He lifted them to his shoulders and carried them to the top of the hill that faces Hebron.

2. Samson _____ the same old sin.

Judges 16:4 Sometime later, he fell in love with a woman in the Valley of Sorek whose name was Delilah. The rulers of the Philistines went to her and said, "See if you can lure him into showing you the secret of his great strength and how we can overpower him so we may tie him up and subdue him. Each one of us will give you eleven hundred shekels of silver."

3. Samson _____ his disobedience would never cost him.

Judges 16:20 Then Delilah called out, "Samson, the Philistines are upon you!" He awoke from his sleep and thought "I'll go out as before and shake myself free." But he did not know that the Lord had left him."
